Students worked hard on their narrative writing pieces this week. An area of continued growth is paragraphing. If your child writes stories or keeps a journal this summer, reinforce the importance of paragraphs for organizing ideas and keeping the reader interested.

This week, we had the chance to "fishbowl" the lit circles and listen in on students as they discussed. We noticed that lots of students raised interesting questions and debates. Our class is full of thinkers. Thank you for your support!

Here is one strategy I noticed other lit circles were using that helped them dig deeper into the text by raising questions that they answered by persuading others of their thinking:

Writing

One of the reasons that you start a new paragraph is:

Spelling: The focus is on consonant blends (bright, planet, tree, etc.).

Social Studies: This week we will begin to explore the role of government, including the 3 branches: executive, legislative and judicial. Math: Students have been working on calculating elapsed time for clocks and calendars. Continue to apply this skill by asking your child start and end times for daily and weekly events.
